

Summary of changes to Florida SHOTS Release 10.1

Changes Affecting All Users:

- Users will now be warned when attempting to change a patient's name or date of birth. This is to reduce the possibility of unintentional changes.
- Polio algorithms updated to make the alternate 3-dose schedule (3rd dose given after age 4y) have the interval from dose 2 to 3 changed from 4w to 6m, as was done previously to the basic 4-dose schedule for dose 3 to 4.
- TDAP is now a separate option when selecting individual series for Reminder Recall. This will allow recall for all patients that are at least 10 years old, have not yet had a valid dose of TDAP, and it has been at least 2 years since the previous DTAP series dose (including TD and TD DECAVAC). The initial view of the Reminder Recall patient list has been adjusted to have the age range at the maximum of 0 to 227 months (0 to 18 years, 11 months).
- TDAP notification added to warning when attempting to produce any Form 680, Part A, when the patient has overdue series which appear on the form.
- Immunization History Report updated to have a more uniform sort order and to clearly identify the dates as "recommended" due dates (as opposed to dates based on minimum intervals). The new sort order is:
 - 1) All named series for which the patient has vaccinations, sorted alphabetically
 - 2) Vaccinations administered which do not belong to a defined series (e.g. Yellow Fever, Cholera)
 - 3) Series for which vaccinations are required but have not yet had the first dose, sorted alphabetically. This section is not history of vaccines received but serves as a reminder of required vaccinations needed but not yet started.
